Further Information:

On the day:

The drop off and pick up points will be clearly sign posted at the site, for those who don't know the site, Whizz Kids staff will be on hand to help you. Please drop off and pick up your child(ren) on time as the club does run to a timetable.

On arrival:

Please make sure your child(ren) have a packed lunch, drink, swimwear (Shoreham College (summer only) and Towers only), sun cream **if hot**, hats, raincoat **(if wet)**, jumper **(if cold)** and any medicines required all must be named & handed in to a member of staff and a declaration form signed. We recommend a change of clothes just in case! Please make sure all equipment is marked with your child's name. If your child(ren) is staying for more than one day at a time, then they may leave equipment and clothing on site overnight if you wish (at your own risk). If you're willing to participate in the Tuck Shop £1.50 must be paid to reception when signing in if not already paid in advance via the website.

Medical Information:

You can update your medical form at any time via our website under the "My Children" page then click view more on the child you wish to update.

Contact Us:

If you need to contact us during the day, i.e., if you are going to be late for pick up. **Call us on 07884 438128, this number will direct you through to our manager Bayley, who can then get the relevant club to call or message you from a private number asap. If the club needs to contact you throughout the day they will use a private number also. For less important matters EG: running 10 minutes late or dad is collecting instead our live chat service is here. Our live chat feature can be found on our website and will leave a message on the tablet for the staff to see and respond to during breaks.**

Please do not phone the school offices.

What is to be expected?

Our aim is to provide a well-structured day for the children.
